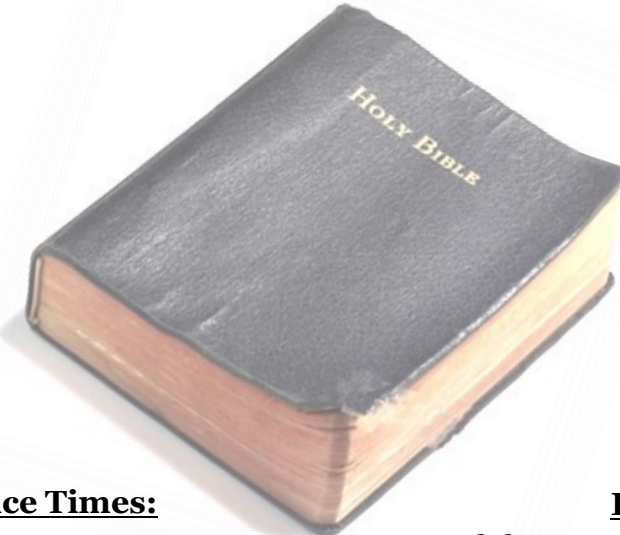

## WE SHOULD REALIZE OUR NEED TO PRAISE GOD

In Psalm 145, one of the Psalms of David; where he explodes in praising God for who He is and because of what He has done.

David used his mouth to "speak the praise of the Lord" (v.21), and not just on a daily basis but "for ever and ever" (vv.1, 2).

In this Psalm, many attributes are listed. Think about each one of these and let them be a source of growth to each of us in praising God.

First of all David speaks of God's greatness. "Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearcha-

ble" (v.3).

Second David is grateful for God's goodness. "They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness...the Lord is good to all" (vv.7, 9).

Third, David is amazed at how gracious and compassionate God was toward him. "*The Lord is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy...His tender mercies are over all*" (vv.8, 9).

Fourth, He is thankful for the Lord's salvation. "*He also will hear their cry, and will save them*" (v.19). *He goes on the say, "The Lord is nigh unto all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him in truth" (v.18).*

Ananias said to Saul of Tarsus, "*And now why tarriest thou? Arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord*" (Acts 22:16).
