

THOU ART GOD

King Hezekiah was one of the good kings in Israel. Many others were evil and led the people into sin.

He lived in a period of time when things seemed hopeless. The Assyrian empire was sweeping the country and surrounding countries, bringing destruction and plunder.

Now this army was at the gates of Jerusalem, with a demand of surrender or they would die.

Hezekiah did not have but one choice, and that was the pray. That is exactly what he did. *“And Hezekiah prayed before the Lord, and said, O Lord God of Israel, which dwellest between the cherubims, thou art the God, even thou alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth; thou hast made heaven and earth”* (2 Kings 19:15).

The leader of the Assyrian army blasphemed and bragged that none of the gods of the nations had been able to save themselves.

To him the gods were just made up and personified and could do

nothing the save the people. *These were just gods created by Hezekiah’s God. “For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the Lord made the heavens”* (Psalm 96:5).

It is true that the Assyrian’s gods were idols. All of those nations around them were rejecting the idea of one true Creator God.

Hezekiah knew better and in his prayer he is relying on the true and living God for protection. As you can read, God did send angels in response to Hezekiah’s prayer, and destroyed a host of the Assyrian army in a single night.

As a matter of fact 85,000 were killed. Sennecherib, king of Assyria went home. No one is able to stand against the true and powerful God we serve.

Therefore, if you have not surrendered your live to Him in obedience now is the time to do so.
