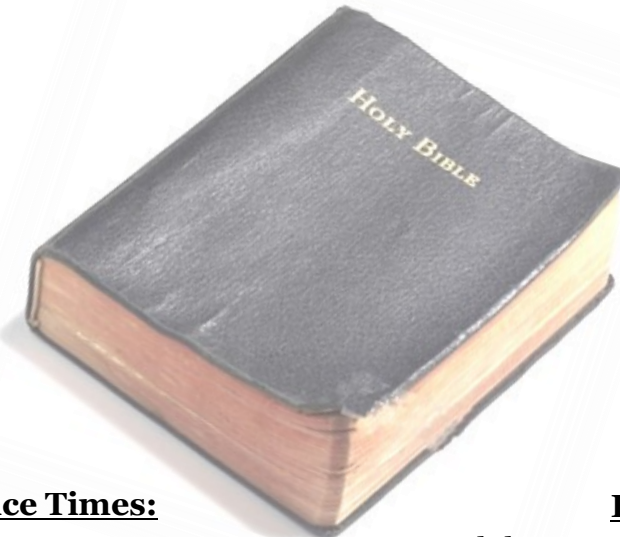

BEFORE THE WORLD BEGAN

“In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began” (Titus 1:2).

There are some things that God, even in His omnipotence, cannot do.

He cannot fail in His ultimate purpose in creation, for one thing. He cannot do wrong, or be wrong, for what He does is right and what He says is true, by definition.

And, God cannot lie, so whatever He has promised, He will perform. So in the text we have a promise of eternal life that was made even before He created the world and humans.

Also including space and time. So how could anything take place before time began?

In 2 Timothy 1:9 we have the same word used. “...*His own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began.*”

Our very minds are locked in space and time, and therefore, we cannot even conceive of anything “beyond” space, or “before” time.

Nevertheless, God is the Creator, and even space/times were framed by the word of God.

“Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear” (Hebrews `11:3).

Quoting the Psalmist, *“Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it”* (Psalm 139:6).

The world will come to an end but we will never end, for we are created in the image of God and will live forever somewhere.

So what we cannot understand, we believe what God has said, because He cannot lie.

He has promised those who are obedient and faithful eternal life with Him.
