

ARE YOU PREPARED TO MEET GOD

"Therefore thus will I do unto thee, O Israel: and because I will do this unto thee, prepare to meet thy God, O Israel" (Amos 4:12).

I am just using this verse to base a short message on; in reality this verse has no particular relation to the Day of Judgment or to the day of death.

It was a military term when God was saying to Israel I will fight against you. So God was saying to them come out to battle.

But, we do know that someday we will have to face God in judgment for sure.

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad" (2 Corinthians 5:10).

"So then every one of us shall give account of himself to

God" (Romans 14:12).

Those who do not believe in God, and those who disobey His will, those who worship falsely will meet God and unfortunately will be unprepared.

There will be no excuse for not having obeyed the Lord. He knows the thoughts of man and understands all about us.

In the coming judgment, "The wicked will be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God" (Psalm 9:17).

Even though the message of Amos was for Israel, it still is something that needs to be heeded by every person:

"Prepare to meet thy God"! For "the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment" (Psalm 1:5).

From the New Testament the scripture says judgment is sure. "It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment" (Hebrew 9:27).

And then in Hebrews 10:3 for those not prepared to meet God it says: "it is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God"

The only way to be prepared to meet God, is by obedience to the gospel of Christ. Why not make the wise decision obey now?
