## JUDGMENT FROM THE LORD

## Jeremiah 37:11-21

When the city of Jerusalem was being besieged by the army of the Babylonians, the prophet Jeremiah was accused of siding with the enemy.

He was arrested and held in a dungeon. Before he was arrested, Jeremiah had spoken again and again, in the name of the Lord and had warned the king that the policies he was pursuing were dangerous and wrong. But neither Zedekiah nor his counselors listened.

When the city was threatened and the prophet silenced in prison, the kind sent for him secretly and asked: *"Is there any word from the Lord?"* (Jeremiah 37:17). The prophet answered: *"There is...You*  shall be delivered into the hand of the king of Babylon."

Zedekiah wanted some word of encouragement. He hoped Jeremiah would give him assurance that the Lord would protect His chosen people. But the word of the Lord was a word of doom.

We dare not expect that the word of the Lord will always be a bright light of hope. When the word of the Lord has come repeatedly in warning, then we must accept the justice of the final word if it comes as condemning judgment.

We very well know from scripture that we will all be judged. If you are not a Christian and faithful we have a word from the Lord and that word is eternal destruction in a place of torment.

Today, there is no need for that, if you will only obey the gospel and live faithful.
