NEGATIVES TO THE UNSAVED

"I know that ye are Abraham's seed; but ye seek to kill me, because my word hath no place in you" (John 8:37).

The Bible describes the person who gives no place to the word of God in his life. The spiritual condition of such a person is revealed in Scripture.

FIRST: he is spiritually dead: Jesus said, "Verily, verily, I say unto you, except ye eat the flesh of the /son of man, and drink His blood, ye have no life in you" (John 6:53).

SECOND: he is in a state of hopelessness: "That at that time you were without Christ... having no hope, and without God in the world" (Ephesians 2:12).

THIRD: he is described by the Lord as one who is withering away: Just like the "seed that fell on stony ground and when the sun was up and it had no root so it withered away." (Mark 4:5-6).

FOURTH: he is one who disregards God entirely: "They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, No, not one. There is no fear of God before their eyes" (Romans 3:12, 18).

FIFTH: he is one who trust in gods who cannot save: "And they... called on the name of Baal from morning to even until noon, saying, O Baal, hear us. But there was no voice, nor any that answered" (2 Kings 18:26).

Yet in spite of the negatives, there are positives that should rejoice the heart of the unsaved causing him to flee to Christ.

The door of salvation has been opened through the shed blood of Christ. (Hebrews 9:22). Making forgiveness possible.

Salvation is opened to all who are willing to receive Christ through obedience to the gospel.

God is no respecter of persons. (Acts 10:34-35).

ALL can come to Him for eternal life.
