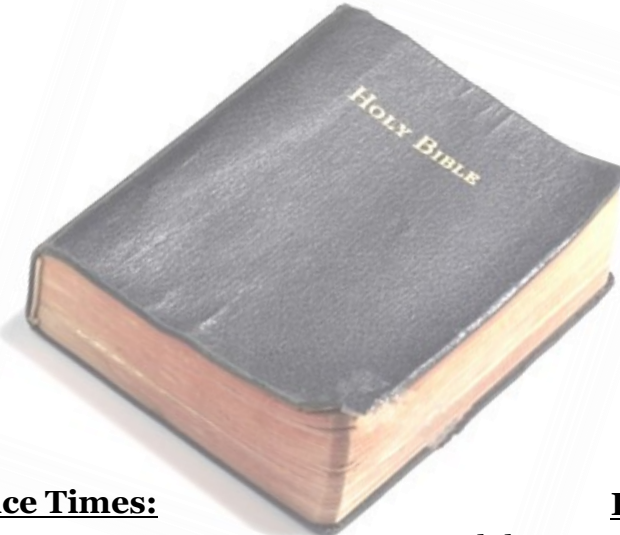

JESUS MISSION

Luke 4:14-21

Verse 18 is a key verse. Jesus had just returned from the wilderness, and as his custom was, he entered to synagogue and stood up to read.

The passage that he chose to read was from the book of Isaiah. Here is what the passage says:

“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, 19 To preach the acceptable year of the Lord” (Luke 4:18-19).

As you look at these two verses you can see that It is a proclamation of hope. It was the good news that the poor could have human rights restored to them. It also promised that the prisoner would be given freedom and the blind his sight.

It would bring assurance that all who were oppressed would be lifted up and set free. Above everything it was a proclamation that God himself had entered into human history.

It brings hope that is central to the gospel and the Christian life. It also a proclamation that points beyond the cross to the resurrection, in which our salvation can be sealed and our hope justified.

This was a message to be preached in all the world for people to hear and believe and to obey in order to have the blessings of salvation and the confidence and assurance that one can have in Christ.

If you are not in Christ consider becoming a Christian.
