### **TWO GREAT NEEDS**

2 Corinthians 1:3-7

There are two great needs that we as humans are provided by God through Christ.

Humans need the mercy, love and grace that God provides for man's sins, and the second is comfort for our sorrows.

For man's sins, God provides mercy so that our sins can be forgiven through obedience to His commands.

Of course all God does for us is through His Son who gave his life, and shed His blood on the cross, so that he could be a propitiation for our sins. (1 John 2:1-2).
