NAME OF JESUS

On the Day of Pentecost, Peter preached concerning how the Jews by wicked hands, had Jesus put to death. Peter also spoke how Jesus was raised from the dead, and had ascended into heaven.

In the fourth chapter of Acts we read these words spoken my Peter and recorded by Luke. "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

In Acts 3, Peter and John saw a cripple man at the temple gate. Peter said: "In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk" (Acts 3:6).

Later testifying to the crowd Peter said: "His name through faith in His name hath made this man strong" (Acts 3:16).

In three of Peter's messages he uses many different names and titles to refer to Christ. Here are several listed.

"The Lord"; Jesus of Nazareth"; "Thine Holy One"; "Christ";

"Jesus"; "His Son"; "The Holy One"; "The Just"; "The Prince of life"; "Jesus Christ"; "A Prophet"; "The Stone"; The Head of the corner."

On the Day of Pentecost, when asked the question; Peter said: "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost" (Acts 2:38).

In the name of Jesus in this passage means by His authority. Peter also made another statement concerning the name of Jesus.

"Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ" (Acts 2:36).

Maybe we get the point that it is only through Jesus that we can have salvation!

But it is up to the individual to decide. God gives you that choice. What will you decide?
