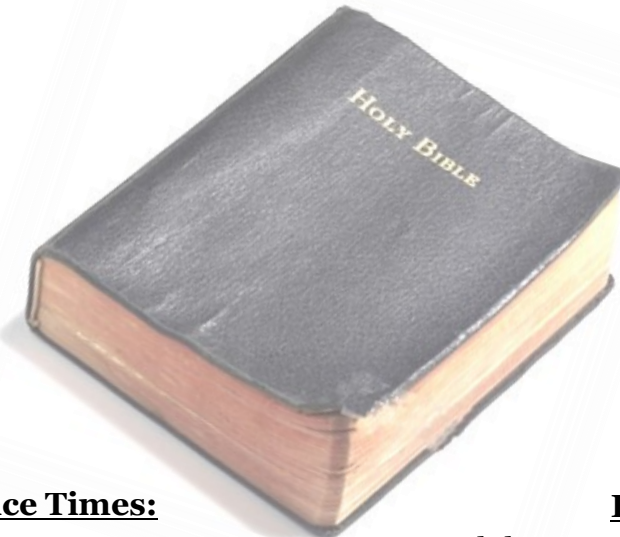

SOLOMON'S INSTRUCTION TO A SON

"My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother" (Proverbs 1:8).

Some of the best information in bringing up children can be found in the book of Proverbs. The purpose of the book is: *"To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding"* (Proverbs 1:2).

There are several things that are laid out like fourteen lesson in regards to my son or children. We have seen the first two. The others are as follows.

"My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments" (Proverbs 3:1).

"My son, despise not the chastening of the Lord; neither be weary of his correction" (Proverbs 3:11).

"My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion" (Proverbs 3:21).

"Hear, ye children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know understanding. 2 For I give you good doctrine, forsake ye not my law" (Proverbs 4:1-2).

"Hear, O my son, and receive my sayings; and the years of thy life shall be many. I have taught thee in the way of wisdom; I have led thee in right paths" (Proverbs 4:10-11).

"My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh" (Proverbs 4:20-22).

"My son, attend unto my wisdom, and bow thine ear to my understanding: That thou mayest regard discretion, and that thy lips may keep knowledge" (Proverbs 5:1-2).

"Hear me now therefore, O ye children, and depart not from the words of my mouth" (Proverbs 5:7).

Some more are 6:20; 7:1, 24; 8:32. All of these show the importance of children listening to the instructions of a father and a mother.

Of course the New Testament has some more to say about this subject. It pays to listen, study and obey.
