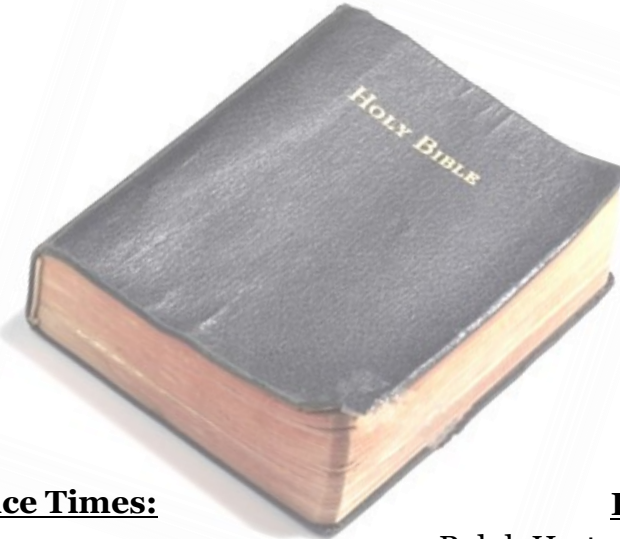

DEAD OR ALIVE?

"And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins" (Ephesians 2:1).
I read where Laura Brooks, a 52 year old mother of two, unknown to her, was one of 14,000 people in 2011 whose name was incorrectly entered into the government database as dead. Many things had happened as a result. She stopped receiving disability and her loan and rent payments bounced. When she went to

the bank to clear this up they told her that her account was closed because she was dead. Of course they were mistaken. Let me ask you this question; are you dead or alive? If you are reading this, are alive? Again, I ask are you dead or alive? There is another way to tell if you are dead or alive, and that is to look at the biblical point of view. When Paul wrote the above text, he made a point of saying to the Ephesians that they were made alive who were dead. So you see, you might be dead and maybe you don't even know it, think about it. You can be dead in the sense that you are separated from God. That is, you are dead spiritually. You are enslaved in sin (Ephesians 2:5), and condemned under the wrath of God in a state of hopelessness. God has a plan for you to become alive in Christ. He is able to give life to the dead. God, in his mercy and grace, sent Jesus to die, so that you being dead in trespasses and sins, might be made alive in Christ. (Ephesians 2:5). Will you stay dead or do you want to live?
