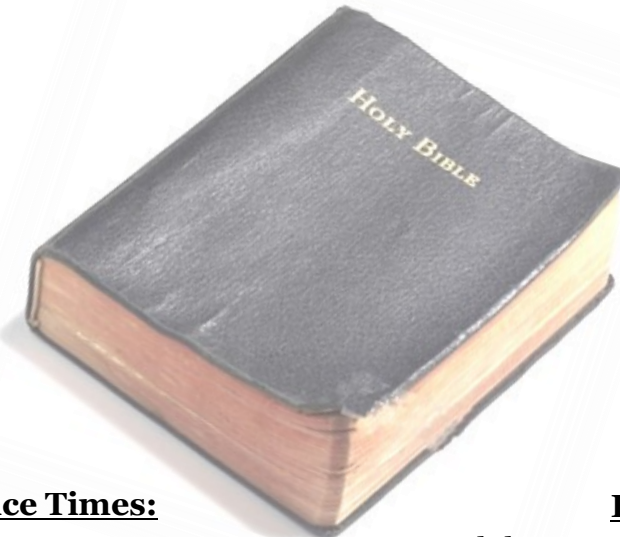

ASSURANCE OF ETERNAL LIFE

"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God" (1 John 5:13).

In this verse there is the assurance. It comes at a result of the phrase: **"You that believe."**

To believe on the Name of the Son of God is to obey the gospel of Christ. You remember that Paul told the Jailor: *"Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt me saved"* (Acts 16:31).

Paul went on to teach him what he needed to do and that was of course to obey the Lord, in being baptized. When on does this he has the blessing of Eternal life.

John says by inspiration. This is something we are assured of. But then, look at the blessedness of having this assurance. **"Ye may know."**

God doesn't want us to be guessing about our relationship with Him. He wants us to know that we have the gift of eternal life.

He wants us to be assured to know and not doubt. How can we thank God for eternal life, if we are not sure we have it?

But, there is something else here in this verse, the ground of this assurance. John says: **"These things have I written unto you... that ye may know."**

This assurance comes through the written word. Words inspired by the Holy Spirit and penned by the apostle are for us to believe and obey, that we may know we have eternal life.

If John writes this, then it is true, and God wants us to have this assurance. We can be joyful and happy living the Christian life, in view of eternal life in Heaven.

The question is do you have eternal life?
