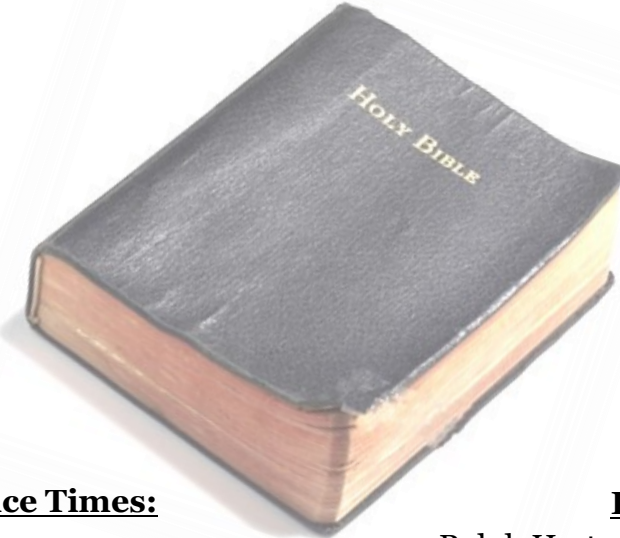

IT IS TIME FOR A DECISION

Matthew 6:24 *"No man can serve two Masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon."*

A time of decision comes to all of us. In the ease of life, we think that we have plenty of time to make the decision that is most important, and that is obedience to the gospel of Christ.

Many have had Bible study in their home and they have been exposed to the truth over and over again, and encouraged too make the decision to respond while they have the opportunity.

The question is why do they halt between two decisions? The decision to obey or to reject is now. Maybe a person thinks that they have lived a good life, and they base their relationship to God on goodness.

As Paul said in 2 Corinthians 6:2 "For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation."
