Ephesians 4:11-16

20 But now are they many members. vet but one body.21 And the eve cannot say unto the hand. I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.22 Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:

23 And those members of the body, which we think to be less honourable. upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness. 24 For our comely parts have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked: 25 That there should be no schism in the body: but that the members should have the same care one for another" (1 Corinthians 12:14-25).
