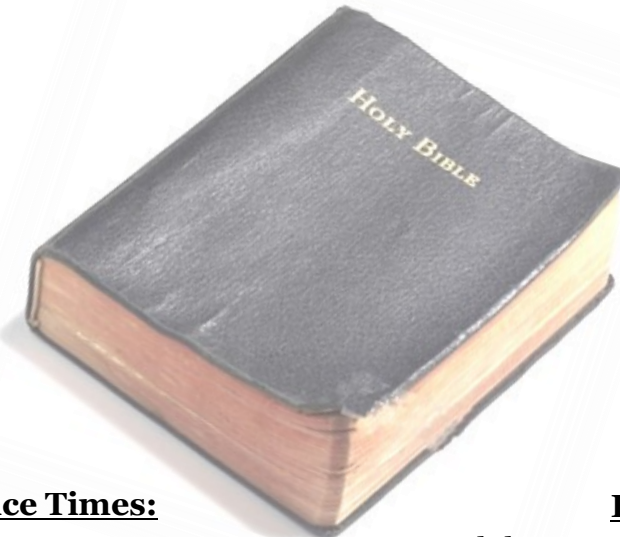

VERY IMPORTANT

Ephesians 4:11-16

It is a beautiful thing to see a well-trained football team play. The ball is snapped. The line blocks well. The quarterback fades back to pass. And at the exact right time the pass receiver turns, catches the pass, and runs for into the end zone for a touchdown.

If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling? 18 But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.19 And if they were all one member, where were the body?

20 But now are they many members, yet but one body.21 And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.22 Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:

23 And those members of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness. 24 For our comely parts have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked: 25 That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another” (1 Corinthians12:14-25).
