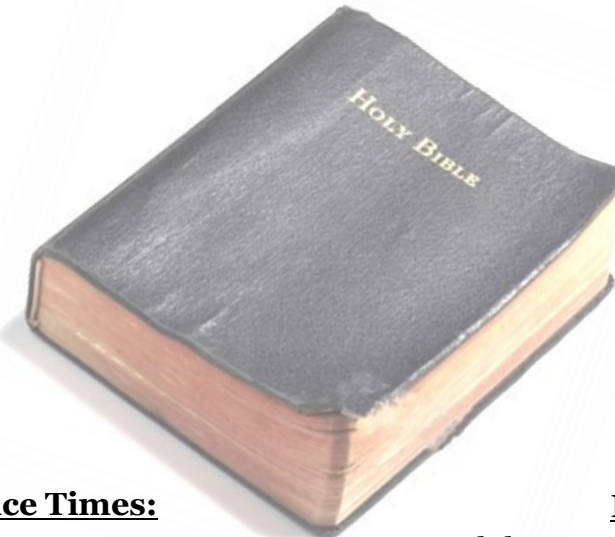

## ARE YOU AT THE BOILING POINT?

Romans 12:9-21

We are all aware, when you go to see a doctor, he slides a thermometer under your tongue.

Of course we are anxious to know what it reads, to find out what our temperature is.

Is it in normal range, or is it a two or three degrees higher?

Most of the time even without a thermometer we know if we are running a fever. If it is high we usually feel tired and have not much energy and just want to rest or even sleep.
