A NEW HEART IS NEEDED

"But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasurest up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God" (Romans 2:5) Jeremiah said this: "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it?" (Jeremiah 17:9).

We take the heart to mean the inward motivations, which control a person's words or deeds. According to Jeremiah the heart is wicked and deceptive and no one can understand his own heart but God does.
