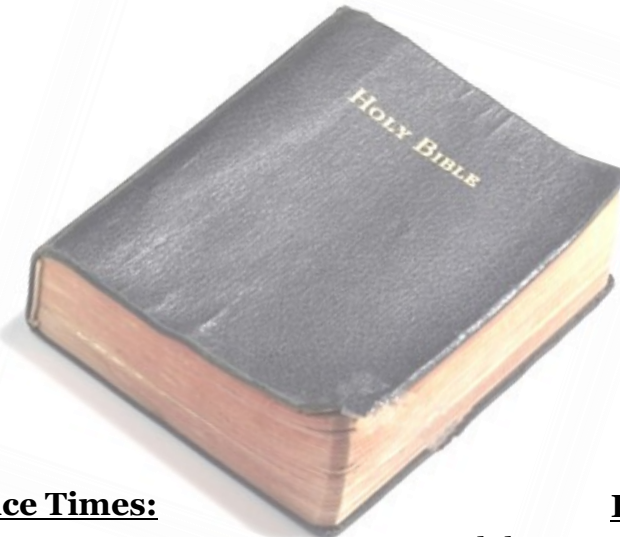

**THERE ARE “NOT’S”**
